Stephanie's Ponytail

1. Background Knowledge

- 이 책에서는 Stephanie 가 머리를 뒤로 묶고 옆으로 묶고 할 때마다 반 친구들과 선생님이 그대로 따라 합니다. 내일은 머리를 대머리로 밀고 올 거라는 말을 듣고 진짜로 머리를 밀고 온 아이들과 선생님은 Stephanie 가 거짓말을 했다는 것을 알게 됩니다. 책을 읽으면서 친구의 머리 스타일을 따라 해 보고 싶었던 적이 있는지, 자신의 머리 스타일을 친구가 따라 해 본 적이 있는지 이야기를 나눠 봅니다.

Mom: Have you ever wanted copy your friend's hairstyle?

Child: Yes, I have.

Mom: What style did your friend have?

Child: She had beautiful braids on both sides.

Mom: Oh, I see. Has your friend ever copied your hairstyle before?

Child: Yes/No.

Mom: Why do you think people copy hairstyles?

Child: Because it looks cool.

Mom: Well, in this story we will read about how Stephanie's hairstyle affected others.

2. Picture Walking

[cover page]

Mom: Look at the cover. What is happening?

Child: I think the mom is making a ponytail for this girl. She is eating cereal.

Mom: What is the dad going to do?

Child: He is going to have some coffee.

Mom: What is the baby doing?

Child: The baby is clapping and laughing.

Mom: Look at the reaction of the dad and the baby. Do you think it is normal that this girl is putting her hair up like this?

Child: No. I don't think it is normal.

Mom: Let's read the story and figure out what happens.

p. 1, 3

Mom: What's going on in these pictures? Can you guess?

Child: These children are running after this girl. They are all have no hair. They look angry.

Mom: Do you think this girl has done something that made them angry?

Child: I think so.

Mom: What is this girl's hairstyle?

Child: She has a ponytail.

Mom: Right. Maybe the story has something to do with her ponytail. Let's move on.

p. 4-5

Mom: Look at this picture. What is happening?

Child: These children are angry at Stephanie. They are yelling and pointing.

Mom: Right. They look quite upset about something. Can you figure out the reason from the text?

Child: They think Stephanie's ponytail is ugly.

Mom: Do you think so, too?

Child: I think it is fine.

Mom: Stephanie says, "It's my ponytail and I like it." If you were Stephanie, would you have done

the same?

Child: Probably.

p. 6-7

Mom: Wow! Look at all these girls. What did they do?

Child: They all have ponytails coming out the back.

Mom: Everyone copied Stephanie. Why do you think they did that?

Child: Maybe they thought the ponytail was cool.

Mom: They said it was ugly. Do you think they changed their minds?

Child: They said it was ugly, but in fact they wanted to copy her.

Mom: How do you think Stephanie feels?

Child: She looks surprised.

p. 8-9

Mom: Here is Stephanie's home again. It looks like the next morning. What is Stephanie doing?

Child: She is looking at herself in a mirror.

Mom: The mom is holding a hair brush. It seems that she just gave Stephanie a ponytail again.

But this time, it looks a bit different.

Child: It is coming out the side.

Mom: Right. Do you like this hairstyle?

Child: Yes/No.

Mom: Do you think Stephanie likes it?

Child: Yes.

p. 10-11

Mom: Look! Everyone copied Stephanie again! Some of them look like boys.

Child: My friend's hair is long enough to make a ponytail.

Mom: It seems that the boys also liked Stephanie's ponytail. How do you think Stephanie feels?

Child: She doesn't like it.

Mom: What do you think she will do?

Child: I think she will change her hairstyle again.

Mom: We'll see. Let's move on to the next page.

p. 12-13

Mom: What is going on in the picture?

Child: The mom is putting Stephanie's hair up, right at the top.

Mom: Do you think that is normal?

Child: No.

Mom: What would Stephanie's dad say about it?

Child: "That looks strange, Stephanie."

Mom: The mom also said it was very, very strange. What will the children think about it?

Child: First they are going to say it's ugly, then they will copy her hairstyle again.

p. 14-15

Mom: You are right! First they said it was ugly, like they did before. The next day everyone had ponytails coming out the top.

Child: There are dogs with ponytails, too!

Mom: Just about everybody is copying Stephanie. She has become a fashion leader! What do you think the children are doing here?

Child: They are having a break. One boy is eating, some are talking, and some are playing with a ball. It looks like recess time.

Mom: Great! What do you like to do during your breaktime at school?

Child: I like to talk with my friends.

p. 16-17

Mom: Look at Stephanie. What is she doing?

Child: She is walking with her ponytail coming out the front!

Mom: Can you walk properly if you do that?

Child: No. You can't see very well.

Mom: What are other people and animals thinking about her?

Child: They look like they think Stephanie is strange.

Mom: Right. Would you like to make a ponytail like this?

Child: No.

p. 18-19

Mom: What is going on at school now?

Child: Everyone has ponytail coming out the front, and they are bumping into each other!

Mom: There seems to be such chaos here. What are the boys doing?

Child: They are running away from the girls.

Mom: Right. They have ponytails coming out the front, too. But because their hair is not too long, they can see better. What is the teacher doing?

Child: She also has a ponytail coming out the front. She dropped a bunch of paper that is flying all over the place.

Mom: Wow! There seems to be a lot of problems.

p. 20-21

Mom: What is Stephanie doing?

Child: She is yelling the kids.

Mom: Why do you think she is yelling?

Child: Maybe because she doesn't like how they copy her every day.

Mom: Now she told everyone that she would shave her head. What is the kids' reaction?

Child: They look surprised.

Mom: Yes, they do. Have you noticed this short boy? He seems to be carrying a different kind of

fruit every day.

Child: Yes. He had an apple, a pear, a banana, and now he has a pineapple!

Mom: Why do you think he is wearing a goggles today?

Child: I don't know.

p. 22-23

Mom: What happened to everyone?

Child: They all shaved their heads!

Mom: Even the teacher has shaved her head! But look at Stephanie. Did she also shave her head

like she said she would?

Child: No.

Mom: Why do you think she lied to everyone?

Child: Because she was so upset with them?

Mom: Probably. Do you think it was nice for Stephanie to do that?

Child: No, it wasn't.

Mom: How does everyone look, when they see Stephanie?

Child: They looked shocked.

Mom: What is happening now?

Child: Everyone is running after Stephanie, and she is running away.

Mom: Everyone must have been quite angry at her. Would you have felt the same if you were

one of them?

Child: Yes. But I wouldn't have shaved my head!

- What is the story about?
- ⊕ What did Stephanie's classmates do?
- How did Stephanie feel about her classmates?
- What happened that was unexpected?
- ⊕ How did the story end?

4. Activity

1) Storyboard
