

suddenly의 의미를 추측하며 이야기합니다.

- Suddenly. Can you guess what this word means?

I'm going to say a sentence and let's guess the meaning of this word.

I get surprised when a car suddenly comes around the corner.

Suddenly means something happens quickly and without warning.

- Suddenly, everybody started shouting.

(dashed)

- In the story, the wolf jumped to Preston but he bumped on the floor. Poor wolf!

What happened to him?

Preston came out of the shop.

Why did he come out?

Because he left his money in his school desk.

How did he feel?

He was worried. He wanted to go back to school as soon as possible.

Let's read this sentence.

He dashed out of the shop!

What does dashed mean?

If you dashed somewhere, you run and go there quickly and suddenly. It is similar to rushed.


- How did it end?
