

Ask Mr. Bear

1. Background Knowledge

- Danny는 엄마 생일에 어떤 선물을 해야 할지 몰라 고민입니다. 소년은 엄마에게 좋은 것을 주고 싶어서 부지런히 이곳 저곳 찾아 다닙니다. 엄마에게 선물을 주는 마지막 장면에서는 흐뭇한 미소가 떠오릅니다. 생일에 누구에게 어떤 선물을 했는지 이야기해 봅니다. 'Baa baa black sheep', 'My black hen' 노래를 들어보고 농장 동물들의 울음소리와 특징에 대해서도 이야기 나누어 봅니다.

Mom: Have you ever given someone a present? What kind of thing did you give?

Child: I gave my friend a card I made.

Mom: Look at this cover. What can you see on this cover?

Child: I can see a boy, a hen, a goose, a goat and a sheep.

Mom: All right. Where do they live?

Child: They live on a farm.

Mom: Yes. They're farm animals. Do you know what sounds they make?

Child: Yes. A hen says "Cluck, cluck". A goose says "Honk, honk". A sheep says "Baa, baa".

Mom: Good! What kind of thing can you get from those animals?

Child: We can get eggs and some milk from hens and cows.

Mom: How about sheep?

Child: Sheep can give warm wool.

2. Picture Walking

[Cover Page]

Mom: When you have a question about something, who do you usually ask?

Child: Mommy!

Mom: A little boy named Danny had a question but he couldn't ask his mommy.

Child: Why?

Mom: Because that question was about her.

Who do you think he asked? Can you guess from the cover of the story?

Child: A sheep or a goose living on the farm.

Mom: How did you know that?

Child: Because I can see farm animals on this cover.

Mom: What did Danny meet?

Child: Danny met a hen.

Mom: Yes. Danny asked something to the hen. What did the hen say?

Child: Cluck, cluck!

Mom: What can you get from the hen?

Mom: How do they move? Are they walking?

Child: I think they're hopping.

Mom: Where are they going?

Child: They're going to meet another animal.

Mom: Can you guess what is the next animal?

Child: Umm...

Mom: What kind of animals did you see on the cover of this book?

Child: A hen, a goose, a goat, a sheep.

Mom: Then what comes next? What is a little bit bigger than a hen?

Child: A goose?

Mom: Let me see. Wow! Absolutely right! What does the goose say?

Child: Honk, honk.

Mom: What can you get from the goose?

Child: I can get feathers.

Mom: Do you know what is made of feathers?

Child: A parka?

Mom: Yes, sometimes pillows are made of feathers.

Mom: They're running to meet another animal. Can you guess what it is?

What kind of animal is bigger than a sheep?

Child: Umm... A Horse? Or a cow?

Mom: What can you get from a horse?

Child: I can get horse hair.

Mom: We can get some milk from this animal.

Child: A cow?

Mom: Does the cow have an answer for Danny's mother's birthday present?

Child: No!

Mom: Why do you think so?

Child: Because this book's title is "Ask Mr. Bear".

I think Danny and the animals run to ask Mr. Bear.

Mom: Turn to the next page.

[page 26-27]

Mom: Why didn't the animals want to go with Danny to find Mr. Bear?

Child: Umm... I think they're scared to see Mr. Bear.

Mom: Where does the bear live?

Child: He lives in the forest.

Mom: Let's go to the forest.

[page 34-35]

Mom: Can you guess what kind of thing Mr. Bear can give to Danny?

Child: I can't guess.

Mom: What is the Mr. Bear doing?

Child: He is whispering something in Danny's ear.

Mom: Why does Mr. Bear whisper in Danny's ear?

Child: I think it's a secret.

Mom: Where is Danny going?

Mom: He looks like he is hiding something. Can you guess what's in his hand?

3. Comprehension Check-up

1) Comprehension Questions

- Why didn't the animals want to go with Danny to find Mr. Bear?
- Why does Mr. Bear whisper in Danny's ear?
- Why is the book called "Ask Mr. Bear"?
- What do you think is a good present?

2) Story Map

4. Activity

1) Read Aloud

- 동물 소리를 재미있게 읽고 Danny와 동물들이 뛰어가는 여러 모습을 흉내내며 읽어 봅니다.

2) Phonemic Awareness : -ug Family Words

- -ug가 들어간 단어들을 익혀 봅니다. ug를 따로 읽어주다가 점점 짧게 붙여 읽어 봅니다.

h---ug, h--ug, h-ug

m---ug, m--ug, m-ug

3) Phonics : Beginning Sound 'g'

1. 첫소리 g로 시작되는 단어 카드들을 보여준 후, g로 시작되는 단어카드 2장을 골라 문장을 만들어 봅니다.

_____ can give you _____.

Gorillas can give you grapes.

Goats can give you groceries.

2. Soft 'g'와 Hard 'g'를 구분해 봅니다.

Hard 'g' : Gorilla, grape, goat, goose...

Soft 'g' : Giraffe, gym, gingerbread...

4) Sight Words : can, find

- 마그네틱으로 can, find를 만들어 보고 can과 find를 넣은 문장으로 미니북을 만들어 봅니다.

- 'I can find _____. ' 패턴에 맞는 문장을 만들고 그림을 그려 미니북을 만들어 봅니다.

5) Vocabulary : Action Verbs 'walk, skip, hop, gallop, trot'

- Danny와 동물들이 뛰는 모습을 생각해 보고 그 밖의 동물들이 움직이는 모습을 표현한 단어를

익혀 봅니다.

walk-skip-hop-gallop-trot

Gallop like a horse.

Hop like a frog.

6) Retelling

- Story Map으로 정리된 이야기를 기억하며 친구들과 Retelling해 봅니다. 제시된 그림들을

막대에 붙이거나 그림 뒤에 벨크로를 붙여 머리밴드에 붙인 후 Retelling해 봅니다.

(준비물: 각 동물들 그림. 막대나 머리밴드)

7) Make a Story

- Farm Animal이 아닌 Forest Animal로 바꾸고 책에 나오는 문장 패턴을 사용해 문장을 만들고 그림을 그려 봅니다.

'I can give you my _____.'

Squirrel: I can give you my tiny acorn.

Owl: I can give you a wink.

8) Art : Making a Card

- 엄마에게 선물로 주고 싶은 것들을 잡지에서 찾아 카드에 붙여보고, 카드를 꾸며 봅니다.
