

The Little Old Lady Who Was Not Afraid of Anything

1. Background Knowledge

- 아무 것도 무서워하지 않는 Little Old Lady가 어느 가을 밤, 숲 속을 걸으면서 벌어지는 사건이 흥미진진합니다. 우리가 평소 두려워하는 것에 대해 이야기를 나눠 보고 무서운 것을 만났을 때 어떻게 행동하게 되는지도 이야기해 봅시다.

Mom: Is there anything you are afraid of?

Child: Yes. (No.)

Mom: What are you afraid of?

Child: Wild animals, ghosts, monsters...

Mom: Why are you afraid of them?

Child: Because they are big and they eat people. They are scary.

They are strong and tough. I can't fight them and win.

Mom: What would you do if you saw a scary thing right in front of you?

Child: I would run away.

Mom: How? Will you run as fast as you can right from the beginning?

Child: Yes. (No.)

Mom: In my case, in the beginning, I would not run. I would just walk fast.

And then I will walk faster and faster. Do you know why?

Child: Yes, because if you run from the beginning it will follow you.

Mom: Right. So let's look at this book.

2. Picture Walking

[Cover page]

Mom: What can you see on this page?

Child: I can see a little woman and a big pumpkin.

Mom: What do we call the pumpkin carved like this?

Child: A jack-o'-lantern!

Mom: Right. When and why do we carve pumpkins to make jack-o'-lanterns?

Child: On Halloween, to make evil spirits go away.

Mom: Good! Where is the little old lady? When is this?

Child: It's getting dark and she is in the forest and maybe walking home.

Mom: Ok. Let's read the title, then -
"The Little Old Lady Who Was Not Afraid of Anything".
Do you think it's true?
What will the story be about? Can you guess?

[Title Page]

Mom: Oh, look at this. What do you see here?

Child: Some corn and a crow.

Mom: What does this have to do with the story? Can you guess?

Child: Maybe the little old lady is growing the corn.

Mom: Yes, it's possible. But who is trying to eat it?

Child: The crow.

Mom: Hmmmm... That is trouble, isn't it? What can she do about this?

Child: She needs a scarecrow in the cornfield.

Mom: Right, let's move on to the story then.

[Page 4~5]

Mom: What is she doing?

Child: She is getting ready to go out.

Mom: Yes! She is going out somewhere.

[Page 6]

Mom: And look here! What do you see here?

Child: A corn field and some crows.

Mom: And can you see something familiar?

Child: It's a jack-o'-lantern.

Mom: So, when do you think this is?

Child: Halloween is coming.

Mom: Right. Let's see the next page.

[Page 7]

Mom: Ok. Time has passed. When is it?

Child: It is night. We can see the moon.

Mom: Can you walk through the woods late at night like this?

Do you think she is afraid? Remember the title.

Child: Yes./ No.

Mom: Let's see the next page.

[Page 8~9]

Mom: Ooooh. What are these?

Child: Two big walking shoes.

Mom: Right, do you think they will be scary?

Look at her face! Is she afraid?

Child: Yes. She is so surprised to see at those shoes.

Mom: What kind of sound do you think the shoes make?

Child: Boom, boom.

Mom: Good. What do you want to see next?

Child: A ghost, a pumpkin. Wild animals!

Mom: What's happening here?

Child: The two shoes are following the old woman.

Mom: And she looks ok now. What will happen next?

[Page 12~13]

Mom: Wow!

Child: A pair of pants this time.

Mom: Let's make sound of pants

Child: Swish, swish.

Mom: Okay, what will happen next?

Please draw your prediction on the paper.

3. Comprehension Check-up

- What is your favorite part? And why?
- Who's your favorite character? And why?
- Who is the main character?
- Where do you think this story takes place?
- How much time passes during this story? (from evening to next morning)
- What was the problem?
- What was the solution?
- If you were the old lady, what would you do?
- Do you have a better solution?
- Have you had this kind of experience? (being afraid of something or someone and running away)

4. Activity

1) Phonics : Initial Sound 'sh'

- shoes, shirt, shake, shining 등 sh로 시작하는 단어들을 책에서 찾아 보고 Worksheet으로 'sh' Sound를 연습해 봅니다.

2) Vocabulary : Clothing

- 할로윈 데이를 위한 시장 놀이 해 봅니다. Shopping List에 사고 싶은 물건을 적고 살 때마다 하나씩 지웁니다.

Mom: Can I help you?

Child: Yes, I am looking for a pair of pants. Do you have any?

Mom: Yes. We have green pants. What do you say?

Child: I like them all right.

How much are they(is it)?

Mom: They are ____ dollars.

Child: Here you go.

Mom: Thank you.

3) High Frequency Word : get, out, my, not, go

- 같은 글자를 2벌씩 만든 후 2개씩 뒤집어 같은 글자를 찾는 Matching Game을 통해 짝을 찾는 게임을 합니다. Magnetic Letter를 활용해 위의 글자를 조합해 봅니다. 6세 이상의 아이라면 조합한 글자를 카드에 한번 흥내내 써 봅니다. 책에서 위의 단어를 찾아 봅니다.

4) Making Different Ending

- 이야기의 결말을 새로 만들어 그림으로 표현하거나 미니북으로 만들어 봅니다.

5) Role Play

- Narrator, Little Old Lady, Shoes, Pants, Shirt, Gloves, Hat, Pumpkin Head로 역할을 각각 나누고 역할에 맞는 그림을 그리고 오려 Mask를 만듭니다. 각자의 역할에 맞추어 Role Play를 해 봅니다. Role Play를 할 때 녹음을 하거나 촬영을 해서 역할극이 끝난 후 들어 보고 Best Actor/Actress를 뽑아 상을 줍니다.
