These Are Animals

1. Background Knowledge

- 이 책은 다양한 동물 서식지와 그 곳에 사는 동물의 동작이나 소리를 실감나게 표현합니다. 아이가 좋아하는 동물은 어디에 사는지 이야기해 보고 그 서식지에 사는 동물에 대해 이야기를 나누어 봅니다.

Mom: Animals live in many different places. Some live in the woods, some live in the grasslands, and some others live in the ocean. What is your favorite animal?

Child: My favorite animal is the whale.

Mom: Where do whales live? Child: They live in the ocean.

Mom: Right. What other animals live in the ocean?

Child: Dolphins, sharks, and lots of fish.

Mom: Great! Many kinds of animals live in the ocean.

2. Picture Walking

Mom: Look at the cover. What animals do you see?

Child: I see bears, a snake, birds, and butterflies.

Mom: Great! Where do you think this place is?

Child: I think it is the forest.

Mom: It looks like a forest! The title says "These Are Animals." We will find out more about animals through this book.

Mom: What animals do you see here?

Child: I see an elephant, a lion, a crocodile, a penguin, and a bird.

Mom: Right. Animals came in different sizes and shapes. Can you think of a tall animal?

Child: A giraffe!

Mom: Great! What about a long and thin animal?

Child: A snake!

Mom: A snake is long and thin! What animals are loud?

Child: A lion is loud, and a parrot is loud, too!

Mom: Good job!

Mom: These animals live in the woods. Shall we say their names together?

Mom and Child: Rabbits, hedgehogs, raccoons, woodpeckers.

Mom: Good! Have you heard rabbits squeak before?

Child: No, I haven't.

Mom: Rabbits are usually quiet, but when they make noise, they squeak. What other animals can

climb trees?

Child: Monkeys, squirrels, and snakes.

Mom: Excellent!

Mom: Here we have some more animals that live in woodlands. What are they?

Child: A moose, a squirrel, and foxes.

Mom: Great! Moose chomp on leaves, and squirrels nibble on nuts. Do you sometimes nibble on

something like a squirrel?

Child: Yes. I sometimes nibble rice chips.

Mom: I see.

Mom: Deer and bears live in the woods, too! How do deer move?

Child: They prance.

Mom: Great! Prancing is moving by taking high steps. What sounds do bears make?

Child: They growl.

Mom: Right

[page 10-11]

Mom: These are polar animals. Here we are in a different place. This is a very cold place with ice

and snow. What animals do you see?

Child: Whales, seals, and a polar bear.

Mom: Yeah! And here are your favorite animals. Did you know that seals bark like dogs?

Child: No.

Mom: What do polar bears have?

Child: They have huge paws.

Mom: Penguins are also polar animals. What are they doing?

Child: They are sliding.

Mom: Yes. They can slide and swim, but there's one thing they cannot do. What is it?

Child: They cannot fly.

Mom: Right!

Mom: Here are some grassland animals. What are they?

Child: They are giraffes, an elephant, a zebra, and a lion.

Mom: Good! What does an elephant have?

Child: It has a trunk.

Mom: Great! It says the trunks are like trumpets. What is this lion doing?

Child: It is roaring.

[page 16-17]

Mom: These are nighttime animals. They sleep during the day and move around at night. What

are some nighttime animals that you see here?

Child: Bats, owls, and wolves.

Mom: Great! The bats are hanging upside down. What do owls say?

Child: They say "Twit Twooo".

Mom: Yes. And wolves howl. How would you if you heard these sounds at night in the forest?

Child: I'd be scared.

Mom: Look at all these eyes! Whose eyes do you think they are?

Child: Nighttime animals' eyes.

Mom: Wow! There are so many nighttime animals in this picture!

Mom: Now what do you see?

Child: I see monkeys, a snake, a parrot, and a tiger.

Mom: Right. These are rainforest animals. A rainforest is where there are tall trees with lots of animals. We'll see what other animals live in the rainforest.

Mom: What animals do you see now?

Child: I see pandas, butterflies, spiders, and a crocodile.

Mom: Good job! They are animals that live in the rainforest, too! What do pandas munch on?

Child: They munch on bamboo.

Mom: Right. What do crocodiles do?

Child: They snap!

Mom: Look at all these birds! How colorful they are! What do birds do?

Child: They sing, swoop, and perch.

Mom: Right! Which one of these do you like the best?

Child: I like this one.

Mom: It looks great!

Mom: These are ocean animals! We saw some polar animals that live in the sea, but here we

have some other animals. What are these?

Child: Sharks, jellyfish, turtles, and dolphins.

Mom: Great job! And we can see how each of them moves.

Mom: Wow! Here we have some more ocean animals. Do you know what these are?

Child: I know starfish!

Mom: Right! And these are called sea urchins. They have spines all over their body. These are

stingrays and crabs. How do the crabs move?

Child: They move from side to side.

Mom: Right! Is it easy for you to walk from side to side?

Child: No.

Mom: What are these?

Child: They are fish.

Mom: Right! There are so many different kinds of fish in the ocean. Where do you think the light is coming from?

Child: I think it is from the sun.

Mom: Great! The sunlight comes into the ocean and brightens it up.

Mom: These are animals. We see some monkeys again. We saw many different animals living in different places. If you could visit one place, where would you like to go?

Child: I'd like to go to the woodlands.

Mom: Why would you like to go there?

Child: I want to see monkeys and parrots.

Mom: Really? It would be wonderful to see them in the woods!

3. Comprehension Check-up

Mom: Great job! What about grasslands?

Child: Giraffes, zebras, lions...
