## Circle

## 1. Background Knowledge

- 이 책은 동그라미 모양의 주인공이 세모, 네모 친구와 숨바꼭질을 하는 내용입니다. 동그라미는 친구들에게 폭포 뒤 어두운 동굴 안에 숨지 말라고 했는데 세모가 그곳에 들어가는 바람에 찾으러 갔다가 또 다른 모양을 만나게 됩니다. 친구와 숨바꼭질을 하며 논 경험을 이야기해 보고, 어두운 곳에 가면 기분이 어떤지도 이야기해 봅니다.

Mom: Have you played hide-and-seek with your friends?
Child: Yes.
Mom: Have you had a hard time finding your friend before?
Child: I sometimes couldn't find my friends.
Mom: What did you do then?
Child: I shouted, "Come out! I can't find you." Then they came out.
Mom: Great! How do you feel when you go into a dark place?
Child: I'm not afraid of the dark.
Mom: Oh really? In this story, some friends go into a dark place. Why don't we read the story and find out more about what happens?

## 2. Picture Walking

[cover page]
Mom: Look at the cover. What shape do you see?
Child: I see a big circle.
Mom: Right. This book is about Circle. Circle has eyes, but no legs or arms. Shall we turn the page to read the story?

Child: Sure.

Mom: Look! Here is Circle. Circle is looking straight at us. Do you see how she is floating in the air?

Child: Yes.
Mom: Does Circle have any legs?
Child: No.

Mom: It says this is Circle's waterfall. Do you think Circle lives in the water?
Child: Yes. Or maybe Circle is just playing in the waterfall.
Mom: The waterfall can be Circle's home or a place to play. Let's read on.

Mom: Now what do you see?
Child: I see a square, a triangle, and Circle.
Mom: Right. Those three friends are going to play together. What are they going to do?
Child: They are going to play hide-and-seek.
Mom: Who is going to count to ten?
Child: Circle.
Mom: Right.

Mom: There is one more rule. What is it?
Child: No hiding behind the waterfall.
Mom: Right. Why shouldn't they hide behind the waterfall?
Child: Because it is dark.
Mom: Do you think someone is going to go behind the waterfall?
Child: Maybe Triangle?
Mom: How do you know?
Child: Triangle said, "I am not afraid of the dark!" So he might go there.

Mom: What did Circle do?
Child: She closed her eyes and counted to ten.
Mom: What is she going to do?
Child: She is going to look for Square and Triangle.
Mom: Excellent!

Mom: What did Circle see when she opened her eyes?
Child: She saw Square.
Mom: Right. Did Square go hide?
Child: No.
Mom: Why not?
Child: Because he wanted to tell Circle that Triangle went behind the waterfall.
Mom: What do you think Circle will do?
Child: I think Circle will go behind the waterfall to find Triangle.

Mom: Look! Circle is really going behind the waterfall! Do you think Square will follow her?
Child: No.
Mom: He thinks Circle is very brave. Maybe he will not follow her.

Mom: What is this place?
Child: This is the other side of the waterfall.
Mom: What is it like?
Child: It is very dark.
Mom: Right. Circle called out to Triangle. Was there any answer?
Child: I wouldn't.

Mom: Circle came farther inside. It is so dark! Did she see Triangle?
Child: No, she didn't.
Mom: She went even farther. If you were Circle, would you have done the same?
Child: I wouldn't.

Mom: It is all dark here. There is no light at all. What should Circle do?
Child: Call to Triangle one more time and then go out.
Mom: Let's see what she does.

Mom: Did Circle find Triangle?
Child: Yes!
Mom: Circle asked Triangle why he always breaks the rules, and there was no answer. Why do you think Triangle gave her no answer?

Child: Because he did something wrong. He broke the rule.
Mom: Circle asked Triangle why he always spoils their fun, and there was no answer. Do you think it is fun to hide in the dark?

Child: Yes/No.

Mom: Here, Circle regrets that she said Triangle was a bad friend. She said Triangle made them worried, and that they loved him. How do you think Triangle will feel now?

Child: I think he will feel good.
Mom: I think so, too.

Mom: Look! Here are three shapes inside the cave! Who did Triangle think they were?
Child: Square and Circle.
Mom: Circle and Triangle found out that there was someone else in the cave. Who could that be?
Child: I don't know.
Mom: Let's see what they do.

Mom: Circle asked the shape in the dark, "Who are you?" But there was no answer. How do you think Circle is feeling now?

Child: A bit scared.
Mom: Right. I wonder why this shape didn't answer.

Mom: Finally Circle and Triangle got scared. They screamed and ran back through the dark. Would you have done the same?

Child: Yes.

Mom: Now they are going through a part where there was not much light. Where will they go if they run more?

Child: They will go to the waterfall.
Mom: Right. It will get brighter near the waterfall.

Mom: Look! There is the waterfall. They went back through the waterfall, back to the outside. Who is outside the waterfall?

Child: Square is.

Mom: Right. Square was waiting for them. Did Square want to go behind the waterfall?
Child: No.
Mom: Right. How does Triangle feel about the dark?
Child: Now he is afraid of the dark.
Mom: Was Circle afraid of the new shape in the dark?
Child: Maybe at first. Now, not so much.

Mom: Now Circle is trying to imagine what shape it could have been. What shape do you think Circle is imagining?

Child: Maybe another circle.

Mom: Then Circle, Triangle, and Square all closed their eyes and pictured a shape. Do you think they are thinking of the same shape or different shapes?

Child: Maybe different shapes.

Mom: What shape do you picture?
Child: I picture a heart.
Mom: Well, that would be a great shape to add to this group of friends.
3. Comprehension Check-up

Circle 과 그 친구들의 이야기를 순서대로 정리해 봅니다.

Mom: What shapes were in the story?
Child: There was a circle, a triangle, and a square.
Mom: Great! What did the shapes do?
Child: They played hide-and-seek.
Mom: Right. What did Circle say the rule was?
Child: They should not go behind the waterfall.
Mom: Why shouldn't they go there?
Child: Because it is too dark.
Mom: But did somebody go behind the waterfall?
Child: Yes. Triangle went there.
Mom: What happened when Circle went there to find Triangle?
Child: They found another shape.
Mom: So what did they do?
Child: Circle and Triangle screamed and ran away.
Mom: Right. Did they know what the new shape was?
Child: No.

## 1) Read Aloud

## 2) Pronunciation - Syllable Counting

- 책에 나오는 다음 단어들을 음절 수대로 분류해 보고 손뼉을 치며 읽어 봅니다.

1 Syllable: square, played, count, hide, dark, here
2 Syllables: cir-cle, some-where, a-fraid, be-hind
3 Syllables: tri-an-gle, wa-ter-fall
3) Finding Shapes in the house

- 집 안에 있는 물건들 중 원형으로 된 것이 어떤 것이 있나 찾아보고 영어로 이름을 말해 봅니다. 또 삼각형이나 사각형으로 된 물건들은 어떤 것이 있는지 찾아 봅니다.


## 4) Hide-and-Seek

- 친구들과 숨바꼭질을 하며 놀아 봅니다. 어떤 규칙들을 세울지 미리 이야기해 보고 규칙을 지키며 게임을 합니다. 할 때 숫자 세기나 "Ready or not, here I come!" 등을 영어로 말해 봅니다.

## 6) Arts and Crafts

Circle 이 사는 폭포와 동굴의 지도를 그려 봅니다. 옆으로 긴 종이에 폭포, 동굴 입구, 안쪽의 더 어두운 곳, 깜깜해서 아무 것도 보이지 않는 곳의 순서로 지도를 그려 보고 이야기 속의 Circle 과 Triangle 이 어떻게 움직였는지 이야기해 봅니다.
